Prepare with Purpose — Track One

BEFORE THE NCLEX-RN

For participants completing NCLEX preparation during the immersion and testing afterward.

Step Into What's Next — Track Two

AFTER THE NCLEX-RN

For participants joining after their planned NCLEX test date, with a focus on transition to practice.

Move from nursing graduate toward professional nurse through meaningful service, deeper learning, cultural immersion and purposeful career preparation.

Note: Participants may change tracks at any time before departure.





PREPARE WITH PURPOSE — TRACK ONE

Keep preparing. Broaden your perspective.

Structured NCLEX review

Nursing knowledge, clinical judgment
and the reasoning behind an answer.

A dedicated learning schedule

Guided question practice alongside
service-learning and reflection.

Ask for the timetable and study expectations before choosing a departure.



Step Into What's Next — Track Two

Build more than your résumé. Build your direction.

Throughout the immersion, guided transition-to-practice discussions help you turn your experience into a stronger professional story.

Your résumé

Document international service, leadership, cultural learning and professional development.

Your first nursing position

Prepare to discuss your experience in interviews and pursue positions aligned with your goals.

Nurse residency programs

Strengthen how you present your readiness, reflection, adaptability and commitment to service.

Graduate education

Explore future pathways and articulate how the experience supports your long-term professional direction.

NATIONALLY INFORMED PREPARATION

The curriculum is informed by nationally recognized nursing frameworks addressing:

APPLY EARLY

Apply Early. Plan with Clarity.

Officially accepted participants receive:

- Confirmed cohort, dates, destination, and pathway
- Defined immersion objectives and expected outcomes
- Planned service-learning activities and anticipated hours
- Transition-to-Practice Syllabus or NCLEX-RN Preparation Map
- Completion and professional-portfolio requirements

Published cohorts are limited to 25 participants.
